

Crime Figures September 2021- 01/09/2021 to 30/09/2021

01/09/2021 Suspicious/ Insecure

Potential poaching incident as vehicle heard during early hours of the morning in the Neasham area. Caller unable to confirm this and no details could be passed over for checks.

01/09/2021 ASB Nuisance

Reports of youths throwing apples at The Grange. No descriptions given. Officers attended however many youths were with parents. There were no issues ongoing and after speaking to the caller, they confirmed the apple throwing had not occurred.

02/09/2021 Highway Disruption

Caller reporting vehicle is parked across a driveway and is blocking access on Hurworth Road. Officers attended and passed details of vehicle for checks. Incident was a misunderstanding due to caller not realising car belonged to a resident staying at their rented property.

02/09/2021 Firearms/ Weapons

Six males potentially poaching in the Neasham area. Officers have attended; however, area search no trace.

03/09/2021 Violence Against a Person

Caller states approximately 15 youths are causing issues and are becoming aggressive in The Grange area. This has led to a crime being created and investigated.

08/09/2021 RTC

Two vehicle RTC on Bridge Road, on the edge of the A66 Roundabout. Police have attended the area to manage the incident until the vehicles could be removed.

08/09/2021 RTC

Call from AMB to report a car vs bike RTC on Neasham Road. Officers have attended to assist with the incident.

09/09/2021 Road related Offence

Caller reporting vehicle for manner of driving on Bridge Road. Partial vehicle registration has been given and observations have been passed to all Darlington Officers.

09/09/2021 ASB Nuisance

Youths seen riding bicycles dangerously on Roundhill Road. No descriptions given by caller. Unfortunately, no officers available to attend due to other immediate incidents.

10/09/2021 RTC

Two vehicles and a lorry have been involved in a damage only RTC on Hurworth Moor. Officers have attended to assist with obstructions on the road.

12/09/2021 Lost/Stolen

Caller believes they have seen an abandoned pedal cycle on Bridge Road, near to Stapleton. Police no longer collect potentially lost property.

15/09/2021 Violence Against a Person

Caller reporting, they have been bitten by a dog. This incident has been crimed and there is ongoing work with local NPT and the Darlington Borough Council Dog Warden in regard to this incident.

16/09/2021 Suspicious/ Insecure

Unknown vehicle appeared in the car park of Rockliffe Hall Hotel overnight. Details have been passed for the vehicle to Call Handler and the relevant checks have been conducted. Unfortunately, due to the area being private land, there is no Police action required.

16/09/2021 Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller reporting unknown males on his property in Neasham. They are questioning the caller about the area and his property. The males have then left the area, details of their vehicle was passed to Darlington Officers. Officers have then seen this vehicle and stopped it in order to speak to the males.

17/09/2021 Suspicious/ Insecure

Two abandoned vehicles have been left in a car park on Strait Lane. They are not causing any obstructions and due to them being on private land, no Police action is required.

19/09/2021 ASB Nuisance

Caller reporting youths have started a fire in Geneva Woods. Upon Police arrival they have made off. A bicycle has been left behind and was seized by Officers and the small fires have been put out.

21/09/2021 ASB Nuisance

Caller concerned about potential drug use in the area around Rockliffe Court and the Doctor's Surgery. NPT visited the area and discussed the issues. Ongoing patrols will continue.

22/09/2021 RTC

Vehicle appears to be abandoned on Hurworth Road following a collision. Details passed to Call Handler and relevant checks done in order to contact the owner of the vehicle. Recovery already arranged by owner, just awaiting vehicle to be removed.

23/09/2021 ASB Nuisance

Caller reporting youths causing issues along Roundhill Road area. Officers attended however area search no trace.

29/09/2021 Suspicious/ Insecure

Caller reporting they have heard noises of persons and lights in the area of The Green. Caller thinks this could be potentially someone checking the garages. No damage was caused in the area, details forwarded onto NPT for patrols. Caller also given words of advice by the Call Handler.
